IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in any Greater Dayton Rowing Association ("Club") activities ("Activity") until the end of this calendar year, I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree and represent that I understand the nature of Rowing Activities, both on water and land based, and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity.
2. FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a.); ROWING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death ("Risks"); (b.) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or the negligence of the Releasees names below; (c.); there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

# GDRA Adult Memberships and Fees

## **New Member**

- Novice rowers must successfully graduate from Learn-To-Row before sending in their membership application.
- Experienced rowers must go through a formal Club Orientation before sending in their membership application. The orientation covers boathouse procedures, river safety and club policies. It includes a rowing test to demonstrate basic competence in a single. Contact the Adult Rowing Director (Linda Clemens 436-9045 or Lclemens@erinet.com) to set up an orientation.
- "New" member means that you have not been a member of GDRA during the past 3 years.
- You will need to get your volunteer hours in this year if you want to qualify for a volunteer membership next year.

## **Renewing Member with Volunteer Hours**

- If you contributed a minimum of 10 official volunteer hours last year, then you are eligible for reduced fees this year.
- If you were a new member last year, who joined after July 1, then the minimum requirement was only 5 hours.
- See the "GDRA Volunteer Program" for complete details.

## **Renewing Member**

- In 2002, as we break-in the Volunteer Program, the Renewing Member fee will be only a token \$5 higher than the fee for a Renewing Member with Volunteer Hours.
  - **In 2003, the Renewing Member fee will be \$150 or \$200 higher than the Renewing Member with Volunteer Hours.**
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## **Senior Membership**

- Minimum age 18.
- Use of club boats and oars at Island Park and at away regattas (subject to availability and prior approval).

## **Student Membership**

- Reduced fee for full-time college and graduate students. High school students should see "Junior Rowing" below.
  - Use of club boats and oars at Island Park.
  - Use of club boats and oars for away regattas is limited to those events at which a GDRA senior member will be transporting and taking responsibility for the equipment (subject to availability and prior approval).
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## **Boat Storage**

- All private boats in the GDRA bays and in the cage pay storage fees.
  - Storage in the cage is at a reduced rate.
  - Storage space is assigned by the Boathouse Manager (Doug Barker 436-9045).
  - Boat owner/user must fill out and sign a Boat Storage Agreement.
  - Reduced boat storage fees are based upon when the boat first appeared at the boathouse.
    - After July 1 = pay 75% of annual fee
    - After Oct 1 = pay 50% of annual fee
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**Learn-to-Row:** An eight class course for beginners and others who want a formal introduction to sculling.

- Use LTR form to enroll.
- **Do not apply for GDRA membership until after passing LTR.**

**Junior Rowing:** A comprehensive crew program for high school students, from novices to competitors.

- Use Junior form to enroll.
- The Junior Rowing Program is run by the GDRA, but it is a distinct program from the Adult Rowing Program.
- Participants in the Junior Program do not typically join GDRA as Members of the Adult Program until they finish rowing as Juniors. However, in special cases, Juniors can become Student Members of the GDRA Adult Program. If you are contemplating applying for this, you must first speak to the Adult Rowing Director and a parent would need to attend your orientation session.
