Incident Report Form

An Incident Report Form (IRF) shall be completed and filed for any incident of collision, swamping, personal injury, and/or damage to equipment either on or off the water. It is the responsibility of the parties involved to file IRFs. Additionally, anyone who observes a breach of the Island Park Rowing Rules or a situation which they consider to be unsafe may file an IRF. The IRF should be completed as soon as possible (and in any case within 24 hours) and deposited in the IRF mailbox in the Boathouse. IRFs on safety incidents will be periodically reviewed by the Safety Committee. IRFs on equipment damage and boathouse issues will be periodically reviewed by the Boathouse Manager.
